

How You Can Effectively Oppose the Proposed McDonald's Development!

As a group of local residents, we believe the proposed development of a McDonald's on the corner of Railway Terrace and Barossa Valley Way in Nuriootpa is inappropriate and does not comply with the Barossa Council Development Plan.

Do you share our view? Are you prepared to make a submission expressing opposition?

How you can make an effective objection

The development application for a McDonald's in Nuriootpa **does not comply with the Council's Development Plan**. The Barossa Council's Development Assessment Panel (DAP) will shortly assess the merit of the proposal against the provisions of the Council Development Plan. We will have an opportunity to voice our opposition by making written submissions to the DAP.

To be effective in opposing the development, objections need to be based on the provisions of the Council's Development Plan. Objections on emotional or philosophical grounds will have no impact on the DAP's deliberations and judgement.

We are currently seeking professional advice. Early in January we can provide information enabling you to make an effective submission opposing the development of a McDonald's on this site. If the DAP refuses the application, there will be **no McDonald's on the corner of Railway Terrace and Barossa Valley Way in Nuriootpa**. A large volume of submissions objecting to the application will help to see it refused.

Are you willing to express your opposition by making an effective submission?

The Council will invite submissions by placing a public notice in the local newspapers. This will occur mid January 2010. **We will have 10 working days to file objections**. We need to be prepared!
